

**LETTER OF INTENT**

**between on one side the Austrian authority and on the other side the Bosnian-Herzegovinian authority for border crossing road passenger transport**

In order to address the issues of illegal transport and undeclared work especially by passenger transport vehicles designed to carry a maximum of 9 persons including the driver, Austria and Bosnia-Herzegovina intend to intensify checks on vehicles registered in the other country and to prosecute them under national law, if such vehicles are used for transport of passengers which, by all accounts, fits the definition of transport for commercial purpose or regular transport (transport operations are carried out repeatedly in the course of one month along the same or similar route through a border crossing point, with at least one border crossing made in a course of one week as a part of an outward or return journey, by the same vehicle carrying passengers and which cannot be associated with the transport of passengers for non-commercial purpose by the driver or owner of the vehicle), and the driver of that vehicle does not hold a proper authorization for that type of transport of passengers.
