

## Agreed Minutes

### of the negotiations on the draft Agreement of the Government of Georgia and the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina on International Road Transport

(Tbilisi, 4-5 November 2013)

A meeting of negotiations on the draft Agreement on International Road Transport between the Government of Georgia and the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina was held at the Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development of Georgia, in Tbilisi, 4-5 November 2013.

The Georgian Side was headed by Ms. Ketevan Salukvadze, the Head of Transport Policy Department of the Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development of Georgia (List of delegations is attached).

The Side of Bosnia and Herzegovina was headed by Mr. Zoran Andric, Assistant Minister, Department for Transport, Ministry of Communications and Transport of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Both sides reviewed the Draft Agreement between the Government of Georgia and the Council of Ministers of Bosnia and Herzegovina on the International Transport of Passengers and Goods by Road article by article.

The Delegations agreed to exchange 100-100 permits valid for universal transport of goods for 2014, and in case of necessity to increase the number of permits. The number of quota is valid till the Joint Committee Meeting is held.

After deliberation, the two sides reached the understanding regarding the final initialed draft of the above mentioned Agreement (attached, 6 pages).

Both sides agreed to start Internal Procedures to finalize the proposed draft by concerned authorities in Georgia and in Bosnia and Herzegovina according to the respective National Legislation to prepare it for signing.


The delegation of Bosnia and Herzegovina kindly invited Georgian side to hold the first Joint Committee Meeting in Bosnia and Herzegovina after concluding agreement.

The Agreed Minutes of the meeting were signed in two original copies in English, both copies being equally authentic.


This Meeting took place in a constructive and friendly atmosphere.
